NTCG NATIONAL MASS CHOIR CODE OF CONDUCT

Individuals who are members of the choir, who wish to minister, are expected to uphold and maintain the following code of conduct:

Spiritual Conduct

1. Bear in mind, at all times that the overall objective of the choir ministry is to lead souls to the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.
2. Maintain positive steps to uphold ones personal Christian witness and devotion both in public and private enabling the overall ministry to be effective.
3. Be regular and active participants of their local church services and activities.
4. Demonstrate at all times, a high level of spiritual maturity conduct, commitment and dedication in accordance with the teachings of the New Testament Church of God.
5. Exercise a reverence and maturity during rehearsals.

Presentation and dress code

1. At events, when representing the church, one should seek to dress smartly but modestly, never seeking to draw attention in such a way as to hinder the ministry.
2. Wear the full-designated choir uniform that may be required or implemented by the directors.
3. Within ones Christian liberty show Christian discipline, maturity and responsibility and refrain from wearing excessive accessories that may cause offence, which in return may cloud the ministry and witness to others.

Support and attendance

1. Encourage honesty and a 'safe' environment where misunderstanding and dissatisfaction can be dealt with in a satisfactory and unthreatening manner.
2. Be sensitive to the needs of other members of the choir.
3. Encourage, support and foster team spirit among members.
4. Demonstrate enthusiasm and co-operation at all times.
5. Make an effort to be punctual in attending the practices and actual events as given by the choir directors.
6. In the first instance members should contact the choir directors, if they are going to be late attending, or absent from rehearsals or events.
